

## **Asset management tasks completed in 2005/06**

- Completion of a comprehensive review of the asset register listings, using information from the 2003/04 asset checks, aerial photography, and field checks.
- Completed the planned maintenance programme for both dams, including removal of a large number of unstable pine trees from the face of the Seton Nossiter dam.
- Completed the Otaki Riverbed survey, and the Otaki Riverbed survey and gravel analysis.
- Completed all planned maintenance and flood damage repairs on the Hutt, Otaki, Waikanae, Wainuiomata Rivers and the Porirua Stream.
- Selected assets on the Hutt River were peer reviewed by the Wairarapa Flood Protection department from the Catchment Division. The reviewers concluded that the assets inspected were being adequately maintained (refer **Attachment 3**).
- John Eyles and Jacky Cox attended a National Asset Management Society training course in the writing of asset management plans.

## **Proposed Asset management tasks for 2006/07**

The following asset management tasks are underway or proposed for 2005/06:

- Complete the review of the base asset management plan document.
- Review the scheme specific documents.
- Complete a review of our unit rates and revalue our asset registers.
- Complete a reciprocal peer review with Horizons Regional Council.
- Produce design channel alignments for the Wainuiomata River.
- Fly each of the five flood protection schemes and produce aerial photography.
