The information in this report relates to the Real Time Information project. Release of this information would disadvantage the Council in negotiations with potential providers as a contract has not yet been entered into and it would reveal Greater Wellington's negotiation strategy. Greater Wellington has not been able to identify a public interest favouring disclosure ofthis particular information in public proceedings of the meeting that would override this prejudice.

That the public conduct of the whole or the relevant part of the proceedings of the meeting would likely to result in the disclosure information for which good reason for withholding would exist under section 7(2)(i) of the Local Government Official *Information* and Meetings Act 1987 (i.e. enable Greater Wellington to carry on without prejudice or disadvantage negotiations).

3. Appointment of non-local government member to Wellington Regional Strategy Committee

The information contained in this report relates to the proposed appointment of a member to the Wellington Regional Strategy Committee. Release of this information would prejudice the proposed member's privacy by disclosing the fact that they are being considered, and have expressed interest, in becoming a member of the Wellington Regional Committee. Strategy Greater Wellington has not been able to identify a public interest favouring particular disclosure this of information in public proceedings of the meeting that would override the privacy of the individual concerned.

Release of this information would prejudice the proposed members' privacy disclosing the fact that they are considered, being and have expressed interest, in becoming members of the Natural Resource Management Plan **Development** Committee. Greater Wellington has not been able to identify a public interest favouring disclosure of this particular information in public proceedings of the meeting that would override the privacy of the individuals concerned.

That the public conduct of the whole or the relevant part of the proceedings of the meeting would likely to result in the disclosure of information for which goodreason for withholding would exist under section 7(2)(a) of the Local Government Official Information Meetings Act 1987 (i.e to protect the privacy *of natural persons)*

5. Refinancing the \$44 million debt

The information contained in this report relates to Greater Wellington's refinancing of the loan Commonwealth Bank with Australia. The report outlines terms ofproposed refinancing. the Having this part of the meeting open public would reveal Commonwealth Bank of Australia's proposed refinancing offer to WRC Holdings Ltd. The Council has not been able to identify a public interest favouring disclosure of this particular information in public proceedings of the meeting that would override this prejudice to their commercial position.

That the public conduct of the whole or the relevant part of the proceedings of the meeting would likely to result in the disclosure information for which good reason for withholding would exist under sections 7(2)(b)(ii)of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings 1987 (i.e to protect information where the making available of information that likely would be unreasonably to prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied or is the subject the of information).

6. Purchase of property

The information contained in this report relates to Greater Wellington entering into a land purchase agreement for a piece of land. The agreement has not yet been entered into. The report outlines terms of the proposed purchase which may still be negotiated. Having this part of the meeting open to the public would disadvantage the Council if further negotiations were to take place as it would reveal the Council's negotiation strategy. The Council has not been able to identify public interest favouring disclosure this particular information in public proceedings of the meeting that would override this prejudice.

That the public conduct of the whole or the relevant part of the proceedings of the meeting would likely to result in the disclosure information for which goodreason for withholding would exist under section 7(2)(i) of the Local Government Official *Information* and Meetings Act 1987 (i.e enable Greater Wellington to carry on without prejudice or disadvantage negotiations).

2. Permits Peter O'Brien to remain at this meeting, while the Council considers Report 09.495 entitled Purchase of property, after the public has been excluded, because of his knowledge of the of the purchase. This knowledge, which will be of assistance in relation to the matters to be discussed, is relevant to those matters because it relates directly to the subjects of the reports.
