I refer to your request for information dated 8 December 2023, which was received by Greater Wellington Regional Council (Greater Wellington) on the same day

You have requested the following:

"What factors were considered in determin ng that Awapuni could supply the root trainer grade and continue with quality, fair market price, and lo istical requirements. Who made the decision to scope nurseries outside of the region and authorise to carry it out. Does the regional council consider a Nursery situated in Palmerston North as local. All the information relating to that decision."

Greater Wellington's response follows:

In May 2022 Scott Ihaka (Team Leader Operations),

(Akura Nursery employee) met with

and yourself at Norfolk Road Nursery. It was stated that Akura Nursery were looking to localise the growing of native seedlings required for internal programmes. Akura required seedlings to be grown in tinus root trainers as the large-scale planting programme is set up to use this grade.

Road Nursery would not be able to grow in that grade but could offer RT28s and RT40s.

Following this meeting

contacted the following nurseries within the region: Wainuioru School Community Nursery, Piwakawa Plants, Pae Tu Mokai Nursery, Kohunui Marae Nursery and Clareville Nurs

y None of these nurseries could meet the needs of Akura by supplying a tinus root trainer grade. Based on this information

was given permission by Scott to contact Awapuni Nursery to source a tinus root trainer grade. Although located in Palmerston North Awapuni Nursery is a more local nursery than one of our current suppliers. As Akura procures plants for our planting
