**Building flood resilience in New Zealand – next steps**

On behalf of Te Uru Kahika I would like to thank you for taking the time to meet with us on the afternoon of Tuesday 17 June and your leadership in this critical area. We greatly appreciated the opportunity to discuss our proposals for improving flood protection infrastructure and regional resilience with urgency.

We acknowledge your continued support for regional infrastructure investment and welcome the constructive dialogue shared during our meeting. As discussed, we are committed to progressing the following action points:

**1. Preparation of a Business Case for the Next Tranche of Investment**

We will develop a business case for a further round of investment in flood protection infrastructure – tentatively titled Before the Deluge 3.0 – with the aim of submitting this to you by the end of September 2025.

**2. Development of a Long-Term Investment Pipeline**

In parallel, we will continue to prepare a comprehensive business case outlining a case for a longer-term pipeline of investment in flood protection infrastructure. This will sustain business confidence to invest in supporting and growing safety and productivity in the regions.

**3. Collaboration with Kānoa Officials**

We will work closely with officials from Kānoa – Regional Economic Development & Investment Unit – to ensure the information is robust, well-presented, and aligned with government expectations.

**4. Work Programme Refinement**

We will work across the sector to de-prioritise any flood initiatives where implementation has not met commencement deadlines. These will be replaced by initiatives which are ready to go. Laggards will be sent to the “back of the bus”.
